

Recycling Plastic Bags & Plastic Wrap at a Drop Off Location Only

Did you know...more than 18,000 stores across the United States collect plastic bags and film plastic for recycling, but many consumers are not even aware of this opportunity?

Recycle only CLEAN, DRY, EMPTY plastic bags and wrap. Plastic MUST be free of receipts, food, moisture or any other items.

EXAMPLES OF THIS "STRETCHY" PLASTIC INCLUDE:

- Retail carryout, produce, bread & newspaper bags, and dry cleaning bags (clean, dry and free of receipts and clothes hangers)
- Plastic cereal box liners (but if it tears like paper, do not include)
- Zip-top food storage bags (clean and dry)
- Plastic bubble wrap and air pillows (deflate)
- Product wrap on cases of water/soda bottles, paper towels, napkins, bathroom tissue, diapers, and magazine subscription wraps
- Furniture and electronic wrap
- Plastic mattress bags
- Any wrap packaging or bag that has the How2Recycle Label shown here:

DO NOT INCLUDE (place in trash):

- Degradable/compostable bags or wrap
- Pre-washed salad mix bags
- Frozen food bags
- Candy bar wrappers
- Chip bags
- Six-pack rings
