

When is Permit Required?

- When is a permit required (<u>12200</u>)? Most activities in road R/W.
 16 listed.
 - 12200 Permit required.
 - (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Division, it is unlawful for any person to do any of the following without first obtaining a permit from the Commissioner:
 - (1) Make or cause to be made any encroachment, including any excavation, in any highway;
 - (2) Place, change, or renew an existing encroachment in any highway;
 - (3) Place, construct, or repair any curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway approach, pavement, base course, retaining wall, storm drain, culvert, pipe, conduit, cable, or other work of similar nature in, over, along, across, or through any highway;



Consequences of Working without Permit

- What are the consequences of working without a permit (12200(b))?
 - (b) Any person who does any of the acts specified in this Section, without first having obtained a permit, is guilty of a misdemeanor and is liable to the County for all expenses and damages caused by the act.
- Any exceptions from permit requirement (<u>12202</u>)? Few, but not related to excavations.



Closure

Permit to Work & Road Closures

- Can excavator close a highway (12206)? No. Soft closures. Bonus.
 - 12206 Road closure, interference with highway use.
 - A permittee must plan and execute an encroachment in such a manner that the encroachment will not unreasonably interfere with the safe and convenient travel of the general public. Unless authorized in the permit, no permittee may close a public highway or deny to the general public the use of the public highway. An exception for filming and special events may be allowed as specified in Section 12218 and Section 12219.
 - (Ord. No. 4540, §§ I, II, 3-19-2019)



Permit Acknowledgement ~ Application & Permit

- **Highlights**
 - Revocable, Hold Harmless
 - Misdemeanor, Perpetuity (continually maintain)

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I understand that any permit that may be granted as a result of this request may be revoked by County at any time. In consideration for issuance of this permit, I agree, and by use hereof, my agents, employees, contractors and invitees agree to be bound by all of the provisions of California Vehicle Code Sections 35780, 35782, Division 12 of the Ventura County Ordinance Code, the Standard Conditions included with this permit and any special conditions hereon, or attached hereto.

I agree to hold the County, its officials, officers, employees and agents harmless from any claims, defense and legal costs, judgments for damages, or other relief against the County as a result of acts, or omissions, by me or my representatives, in the performance of any activities permitted hereunder, whether the condition giving rise to the claim or judgment was created in whole, or in part, by me or my representatives.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT CONTINUED

I understand that a violation of the conditions would constitute a violation of the encroachment ordinance which is a misdemeanor per section 12301 and is guilty of separate offenses for every day and part thereof which such violation remains. I agree to comply with all conditions of approval for the permit. I further agree to continually maintain all encroachments authorized by this permit in a condition acceptable to the County.



Engineer Perspective – Public Safety

- Public Safety ~ Access and Safety
- Encroachment removal (<u>12208</u>)
 - (a) The Commissioner may immediately remove, or require the removal or relocation of, any encroachment, lawful or unlawful, that:
 - (1) Obstructs or prevents the use of a County highway by the public;
 - (2) Consists of refuse;
 - (3) Is a traffic hazard;
 - (4) Is an advertising sign or device and is removable under section 1480.5, subdivision (d), of the Streets and Highways Code; or
 - (5) Is detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare.
 - (b) Removal and relocation of encroachments under this Section are governed by the procedure provided in, and the permittee is liable for all penalties and damages described in, section 1480 et seq. of the Streets and Highways Code.

Abandonments

- Abandoned pipelines are encroachments.
- Since March 2019, VCPWA-RT has been enforcing this provision of the updated EO. May not be a new provision.
- Encroachment removal without replacement (<u>12209</u>).
 - When an encroachment is removed and not replaced, the permittee must remove the entire encroachment from the right-of-way and restore the right-of-way to meet standards specified elsewhere in this Division, unless the Commissioner authorizes otherwise, in writing. Pipes may be abandoned in place with prior written approval from the Commissioner. When abandoned in place, pipes must be tested and filled by a method approved by the Commissioner or as required by the franchise agreement. (Ord. No. 4540, §§ I, II, 3-19-2019)



Abandonment Requests

- What should utility do if the utility wants to abandon pipes in the county road right-of-way?
 - Formal request.
 - Understand request may be denied. It may be approved.
 - Criteria we use. We are trying to be more ministerial and less discretionary.
 - Questionnaire/Survey. This is new and a work in progress.
 - Letter

SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ABANDON PIPELINES IN-PLACE COUNTY MAINTAINED ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

Dear Utility:

Ventura County Public Works Agency - Roads & Transportation (VCPWA-RT) has jurisdiction over roadways in the unincorporated areas of Ventura County. Your project is located in/on a county-maintained road right-of-way.

The Road Commissioner approves and authorizes abandoned pipelines in/on countymaintained road right-of-ways^. Pipeline abandonments are DENIED until approval is granted by the Road Commissioner.

Encroachment Permit holders are required to follow local laws and regulations, including the Municipal Code. Abandoned pipelines are not permitted to remain without proper approval from the Road Commissioner. After removal, Permit holder or project sponsor must restore the road right-of-way to its pre-existing condition (before the pipeline was installed)

Any request to abandon pipelines must be received in writing on agency letterhead. In order for VCPWA-RT to evaluate the abandonment request, the agency or sponsor must fill out the following questionnaire/survey.

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Please allow at least two (2) weeks for Staff to evaluate your request. You will receive a denial or approval letter in writing from the Road Commissioner.







Abandonment Criteria

- Basic data needed.

- Plans prepared by Engineer.
- Abandoned pipe.

- 1. The request to abandon the water mainline did not provide sufficient justification for the PWATD to approve the request. While you indicate there is a gas line nearby, the presence of another utility nearby does not of itself provide justification to allow abandonment and not removal of the existing line pipeline.
- 2. Based on our assessment, (a) the segment to be removed is relatively short (135 feet), (b) shallow in depth (less than five (5) feet), and (c) will not present a significant cost to the owner of the utility to remove the inactive pipeline.
- 3. Removal of the pipeline at this time eliminates a future expense to another party that may be crossing the utility or desiring to use the space in the right-of-way.







Traffic Control Plans – Typical Applications (TA-3,6,10)









Apply for Permits

Encroachment Permits are required for any work proposed within the Coupty's road right-of-way and includes such work as utility installations and repairs, roadway and drainage improvements by developers, driveway construction, sidewalk repair, filming of motion pictures and still photography, placement of obstructions in the right-of-way such as fences, trees, poles, and overhead structures. Roadside vendors are not permitted in the road right-of-way. The Permits Section ensures that all construction work in the public right-of-way complies with County's adopted codes and engineering standards. In addition, the Section issues Transportation Dermits for oversize vehicles travelling on County roads and collects Traffic Impact Mitigation fees. In 2020, a new Moopt-a-Road Program road roadside litter cleanup was



VENTURA COUNTY ROAD INVENTORY AND INDEX



The Ventura County Road Inventory and Index lists the County maintained public roads.

These roads have been formally accepted into the County road system as county highways by the Board of Supervisors or a designated representative. Only county highways are eligible to be maintained with County Road Funds. Roads not listed in the Road Inventory and Index are either city streets, private roads, or roads that have acquired public status by one means or another, but have not been accepted as county highways. Only the listed limits of roads are county highways. Many roads have city sections or nonmaintained sections that are outside of the limits of the county highway.

This Road Inventory and Index is hereby certified as the record of each county highway under Streets and Highways Code Section 908.

DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

ROAD NAME - The Board of Supervisors officially names roads after review by Resource Management Agency - Planning Department staff and the Fire Protection District. The policy is to avoid duplication and keep the names as short as possible.

LIMITS - Road limits are described narratively to be easily recognized.

MAINTAINED MILES - Length is in miles to the nearest hundredth and is measured from the centerline of intersecting streets.

RIGHT-OF-WAY (ROW) - Dedicated easement width. A " * " denotes ROW width varies for the section shown.

FEDERAL FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION (FED FCL)

US UNITS	REVISION:	PLATE E-11

PLATE E-11 NOTES:

- Construction shall conform to Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (SSPWC)
 except as noted.
- 2. Trench width shall be as shown unless otherwise shown on the approved plans.
- Bedding material shall be granular with 100% passing 3/4" sieve, 90 to 100% passing the 3/8" sieve and not more than 4% passing No. 200 sieve.
- Backfill between the bedding zone and subgrade shall be Trench Backfill Slurry Class 60-E-0.7 (100-E-100). The Director of Public Works may approve the substitution of one of the following:
 - Controlled Low Strength Material (SSPWC 201-6), provided that laboratory control is provided to insure compliance with the specifications.
 - b. Non-cementitious backfill, provided that the backfill is tested and certified to meet the approved specifications for the material by an independent testing laboratory (SSPWC 217-2). A Quality Control Plan shall be submitted for approval.
- 5. Compaction shall not use flooding, ponding or jetting unless directed by Soils Engrineer.
- 6. A.C. Overlay shall be C1 or C2 PG 64-10, 1.5" minimum.
- AC Base Layer
 - a. Where existing pavement surface is AC the AC Base Layer thickness shall be equal to or greater than the existing AC thickness plus 1" with a minimum of 3" and a maximum of 8". For roads where Traffic Index is 7.0 or greater (Plates B-2, B-3 & B-7a), the AC Base layer thickness shall be 4" min.
 - b. Where existing pavement surface is PCC pavement, saw cut 2" into the existing pavement at the outer edge of the trench and break the remaining thickness. Replace the PCC and base to the same depth as the existing pavement. The PCC shall be 560-C-3250.



Pavement Repairs for Trenching CRS Plate E-11

- Highlights
- 1-foot T-cut ~ Excavation is 4x4, then final paving 5x5.
- Backfill slurry above pipe zone. Discourage alternatives.
- Depth of pipe ~ 36 inches in pavement or shoulder.
- 1-inch plus rule of thumb ~ Existing base plus 1 inch.
- Timing ~ Complete final paving as soon as possible.
- Approval ~ Call Inspector for Inspection or provide photographs of process/work and tickets for slurry backfill and asphalt concrete.
- Inspections ~ Inspector will have limited time with Excavator due to other pending inspections.



Highlights

- Moratorium Roads ~ Ideally complete utility work before D&C construction project.
- Moratorium ~ ½ inch overlay or greater ~ 5 years.
- Moratorium ~ ½ inch overlay or less ~ 3 years.
- Additional paving required for following Excavation scenarios.
 - Exc. outside travel lane ~ no change (1-foot T-cut)
 - Exc. crosses centerline ~ full road width overlay (1-foot beyond).
 - Within travel lane ~ full lane width overlay (1-foot beyond).
 - Diagonal to centerline ~ full road width overlay (1-foot beyond).



Submittal. By submitting a signed permit application, permittee accepts and agrees to comply with all terms and conditions, including those appearing on the permit application, these administrative permit conditions, the standard conditions, and all special permit-specific conditions.

Conditions. Permittee is responsible for compliance with all conditions of the permit, regardless of whether permittee employs contractors or others to perform the work.

Violation. Failure to comply with any condition of the permit, including work contrary to any condition of the permit, constitutes a misdemeanor violation of Ventura County Ordinance 4540 (EO 4540) approved by the Board of Supervisors on March 19. 2019.

Compliance and penalties. In order to ensure compliance with the conditions of the permit and in accordance with EO 4540, failure to abide by the permit conditions, including notification for inspections and emergency work, may result in one or more of the following: penalty or changes in permit fees; permit modification or revocation; permit issuance when separate individual permit required; removal or modification of the encroachment; reconstruction or repaving of the pavement or shoulder; paving restoration by County paving contractor.

EMERGENCY REPAIRS:

Emergencies. Emergency repairs require an immediate email to PWM_TransPemits@ventura.org and phone call to the Permits Section at (805) 654-2055. In the email and phone message, provide the road name, contractor and permittee name, time and date of the incident. An application for the emergency work must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. the next business day. Failure to comply and working without a permit will be treated as stated here below.

SEPARATE INDIVIDUAL PERMIT REQUIRED:

Separate permit. A separate individual permit is required when ANY of the following are true:

- Excavation is required, including, but not limited to, pole replacements, pole reinforcement, or any such preparatory work.
- (2) Work duration is more than eight (8) hours.
- (3) Location of work and traffic conditions do not meet Scenario #1 or Scenario #2 below or require a road closure.

If any of these above are true, then the work is NOT covered under the Administrative Permit and a separate individual permit is required. For application requirements, please read Requirements for Application Submittal here below. Permit applications may be found at: https://www.vcpublicworks.org/appl/forpermits/.

Small excavations. Administrative permit holders may be eligible for a small excavation permit with the review fee waived. Small excavation permits are defined here below.

Thirty (30) square feet or less and layout is anywhere in pavement or shoulder.

All construction must conform to the encroachment permit, these standard conditions, any special conditions, the Encroachment Ordinance (EO) 4540 (Ventura County Ordinance Code § 12000 et seq.) approved by the Board of Supervisors (BOS) on March 19, 2019 (EO 4540), the County Road Standards (CRS) approved by the BOS (CRS), the most current version of the Standard Plans and Specifications for Public Works Construction (SPPWC) (SPPWC), the Standard Land Development Specifications (SLDS), and the Ventura Countywide Storm Water Quality Management Program (VCSWQMP) (VCSWQMP) as part of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit CASO04002 (Permit) as well as all State and Federal requirements of the Clean Water Act or as approved by the County. All of the above documents are incorporated herein by reference.

Inspection. Permittee must confer with Ventura County Public Works Agency Roads & Transportation (VCPWA-RT) (NCPWA-RT) Inspector (Inspector) listed on the permit or their designee and obtain approval to start work no later than two (2) working days prior to the desired start date. In addition, Permittee must call the Inspector before placing concrete. Failure to abide by permit conditions, required notifications, and inspections may result in one or more of the following: penalty fees; permit revocation; removal of the encroachment; reconstruction of the encroachment.

WORKING WITHOUT A PERMIT:

Violation. Any person who performs work or conducts activities in the right-of-way of a county-maintained roadway that would require a permit is guilty of a misdemeanor and is liable to the County for all expenses and any damages caused by the work or activity. VCPWA-RT may issue any permit on behalf of the person performing the work or conducting the activity without pre-application and the Permittee will be subject to all fees and costs required by the permit and the most current fee schedule (Fees). Any work without a permit is subject to penalty fees. For more information, see EO 4540 (EO 4540).

WORKING WITH AN EXPIRED PERMIT:

Extensions. Any valid permit that has expired with work not completed will be automatically extended ninety (90) days by the County's permitting software and charged a permit extension fee. If requested in writing prior to the permit expiration date, one extension of a reasonable duration will be granted at no charge. 
PLATE E-11 NOTES:

- Construction shall conform to Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (SSPWC)
 except as noted.
- 2. Trench width shall be as shown unless otherwise shown on the approved plans.
- Bedding material shall be granular with 100% passing 3/4" sieve, 90 to 100% passing the 3/8" sieve and not more than 4% passing No. 200 sieve.
- Backfill between the bedding zone and subgrade shall be Trench Backfill Slurry Class 60-E-0.7 (100-E-100). The Director of Public Works may approve the substitution of one of the following:
 - Controlled Low Strength Material (SSPWC 201-6), provided that laboratory control is provided to insure compliance with the specifications.
 - b. Non-cementitious backfill, provided that the backfill is tested and certified to meet the approved specifications for the material by an independent testing laboratory (SSPWC 217-2). A Quality Control Plan shall be submitted for approval.
- 5. Compaction shall not use flooding, ponding or jetting unless directed by Soils Engrineer.
- A.C. Overlay shall be C1 or C2 PG 64-10, 1.5" minimum.
- 7. AC Base Layer
 - a. Where existing pavement surface is AC the AC Base Layer thickness shall be equal to or greater than the existing AC thickness plus 1" with a minimum of 3" and a maximum of 8". For roads where Traffic Index is 7.0 or greater (Plates B-2, B-3 & B-7a), the AC Base layer thickness shall be 4" min.
 - b. Where existing pavement surface is PCC pavement, saw cut 2" into the existing pavement at the outer edge of the trench and break the remaining thickness. Replace the PCC and base to the same depth as the existing pavement. The PCC shall be 560-C-3250.







Traffic Control Plans


- Review of Traffic Control Plans:
 - Speed limits correctly indicated for each road
 - Proper advance warning signs and spacing must be shown per California MUTCD, also including cone layout with buffer zones
 - 10' Minimum lane width(s) on pavement are provided (minimum 12' lane width against a curb) utilizing the hard dirt or gravel shoulder is not permitted for public travel
 - Maintain 2-directional travel through the work zone
 - Pedestrian detour routes provided, if applicable
 - Date(s) and Time(s) of the scheduled work



Traffic Control Plans

Road Closures

- All road closures require a traffic control plan.
 Depending on the complexity of the proposed work, a traffic control plan may be requested even if the road will not be completely closed.
- Detour routes are provided for road closures (exception: dead-end roads) with adequate directional signage
- Hard vs soft closures:
 - Hard closures are roads that are closed to all traffic except Police and Fire Department.
 - All road closures for utility work are considered soft closures. Soft closures allow work to be performed without the flow of traffic, but will facilitate a resident or emergency vehicle to pass through the work zone.

Preliminary Engineering Phase (0 - 35%)

- First Utility letters sent
- Project Managers update/review utility log and notes any potential conflicts
- Coordination with Utility company
- Notice to relocate or adjust to accommodate utilities

Design Phase (35 % – Bidding Process)

- Utility Relocation/Right-of-Way process
- Acquisition from Real Estate Services
 (6 months 1 year, varies)
- Resolution of utility conflict
- Second Utility letters sent

Coordination with Utility companies, field markings



Paving Utility Letters

- Five year moratorium
- 2 Notifications
- Adjust to grade within 3 weeks of project completion – no permit fee



 - Begin road closure process.
 - Emergency and local access must be maintained.






How many road miles are in the unincorporated areas?




